 1. Lecture-5%
 2. Reading-10%
 3. Audio-Visual-20%

- Active Teaching Methods
 1. Group Discussion-50%
 2. Doing by Practice-75%
 3. Teaching Others-90%

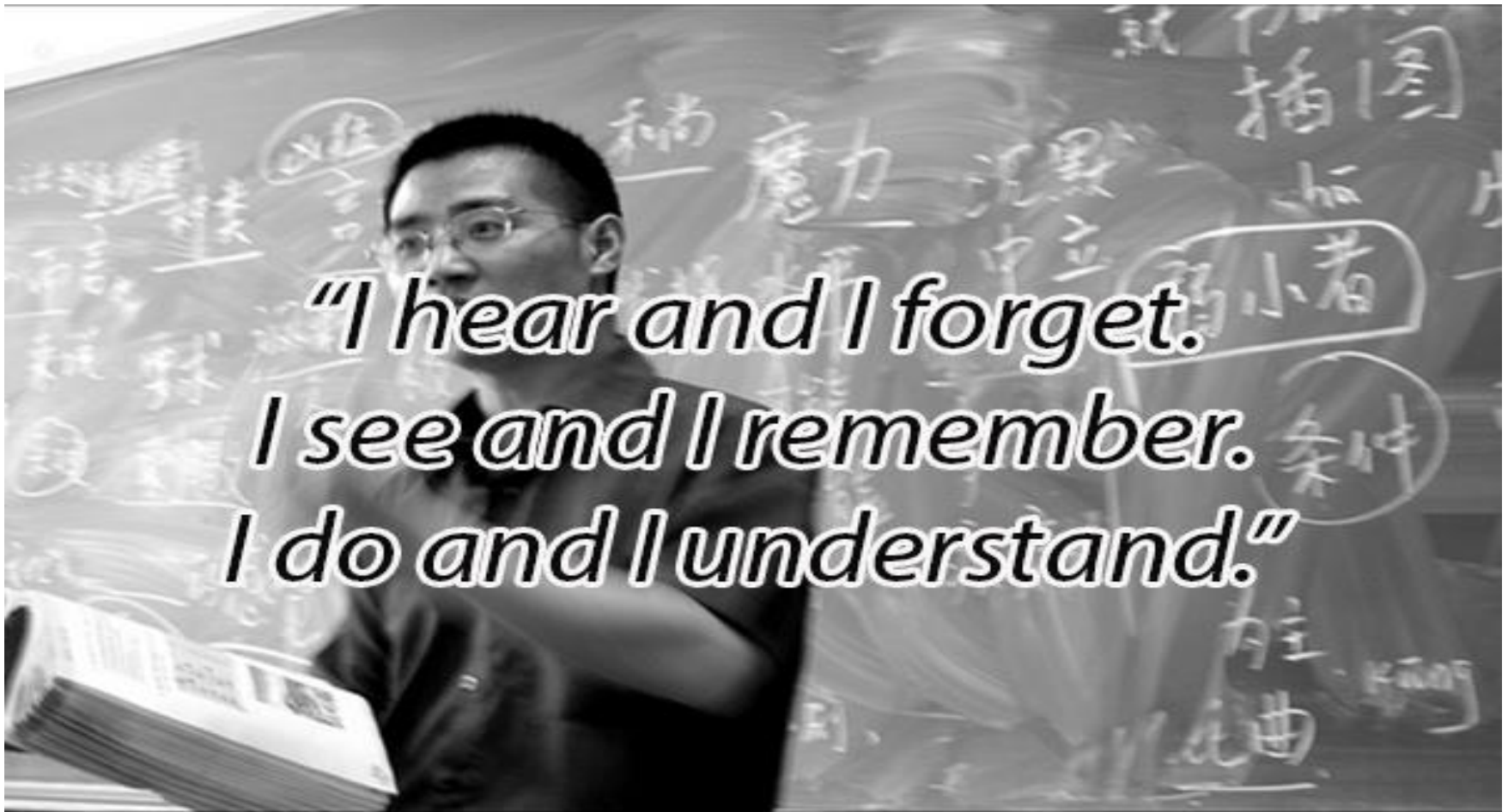


